2. Access from Brussels Airport and main Train Stations

From Zaventem Airport:

From Charleroi Airport:

You may need to take either the bus or a shared shuttle (https://www.flibco.com/fr/shuttle/navette-bruxelles-aeroport-charleroi)

From Train Station:

- Brussels South/Bruxelles Midi/Brussel Zuid: Take METRO line 2 or 6 direction" Elisabeth" until the stop Trône/Troon, then walk 10 minutes to rue Vautier 29.
- Others Please go to SNCB website (see below)

3. Public transport

Use of public transport is very advisable. For those driving their own car, there are few parking public spaces, in the front area of the museum. Please, let us know if that is your option.

Train

Brussels-Luxembourg train station is a five-minute walk from the museum.





Bus

Bus 38 or 95 to "Idalie" or "Luxembourg" bus stops which are a five-minute walk from the museum.

Bus 34 or 80 to "Museum" bus stop, opposite the museum.

Metro

Line 1 or 5 "Maelbeek/Maalbeek" station, then it is a ten-minute walk to the museum. Line 2 or 6 to "Trône/Troon" station, then it is a ten-minute walk to the museum.

Villo!

There are several Villo! bike rental stations near the museum. The nearest, station no. 102, is located just outside the Museum, at the base of the outside staircase, facing 229-233 Chaussée de Wavre.
